Notice to Participants: In response to COVID and for the safety of our veterinarians and volunteers, health clinic clients will wait in their vehicles for the duration of the exam. Clinic volunteers will retrieve the animals from the client for the veterinarian to perform the exam. Dogs will be returned to their owners once the exam is complete. The veterinarian will call you on your cell phone at the conclusion of the exam to discuss the findings.

To help our clinic volunteers maintain efficiency, clients should do the following:

- 1.) Put a piece of paper with your last name and breed(s) of dogs on the windshield, so that the clinic volunteers can easily locate you and your animal.
- 2.) Provide clinic volunteers with your cell phone number and color and model of your car when the retrieval of your pet (s).
- 3.) For CAER Eye Exams - Complete CAER Eye application through the new OFA online platform (instructions Next Page)

CAER Eye applications will be completed through the Orthopedic Foundation for Animals' new online platform, OFA Online. The new platform simplifies the process for owners and veterinarians and it speeds up the process for OFA submissions. Owners are even able to pay OFA through their online account.

To get started, you will go to www.ofa.org/online and create an account. Once you are in your account you will create a new application, fill in your dog's information, and search for Dr. van der Woerd as the ophthalmologist who will be completing the exam. Creating an account, means you will have access to all of your dog's records as you create applications in OFA Online and can track the progress of each application through your account. Once the application has been created, it will automatically be available to Dr. van der Woerd when you come to your appointment. Dr. van der Woerd will complete the the exam results online and once it has been completed you will automatically receive an email with a PDF version of the results. You will then have access in your account to submit the application to OFA and pay the fee all online.

Summary of Step By Step Instructions for Creating An Online OFA Account:

- Create an Account -

- 1.) Go to www.ofa.org/online
- 2.) Click on "Start Here"
- 3.) Create owner account
- 4.) Log into new account
- 5.) Review handbook (left side of screen)

- Create New Application -

- 1.) Fill in dog's information
- 2.) Select CAER Eye exam
- 3.) Search and select the ophthalmologist
- 4.) Log in to OFA Online
