AKC NEWS - Peg Vohr

Delegates Meeting

At the AKC Delegates meeting, held on March 7 and 8, we voted to fill three vacancies on the AKC Board of Directors. Patricia M. Cruz and William J. Feeney were reelected to the Board. Karolynne McAteer, Irish Setter Club of America, was elected to fill the third vacancy We voted on a proposal to allow Delegates Judges to charge up to \$150.00 per day over and above their expenses. The proposal required a two-thirds affirmative vote and it was defeated with a roughly 50-50 vote. A second vote was held on an addition to the Beagle Field Trial Rules. This addition would create a National Championship event for the Beagle Two-Couple Pack Sport. The amendment was adopted.

President Dennis Sprung announced that, for the first time since 1996, both the total of individual registered dogs and of litters exceeded the prior year's total. He again emphasized the importance of individual clubs ensuring that both long-term and new exhibitors always receive a positive and welcoming experience from club officials, superintendents, and judges.

AKC Political Action Committee (PAC)

Board of Directors member Carl Ashby brought the Delegates up to date on the AKC PAC at the Tuesday general meeting. AKC Government Relations Dept.is already tracking 1400 bills this year. AKC does hire lobbyists in these situations in addition to supporting local federations. We are aways behind the financial eight ball; HSUS invests about \$66 million to influence public opinion, while the AKC invests about \$1 million, coupled with our PAC money The AKC PAC is the only way we have to influence legislation; the AKC as a non-profit organization is unable to contribute directly to a candidate.

I was startled to learn that despite the fact that there are 625 member clubs, only 292 contributed to PAC last year. Donating to PAC is really an investment to protect our right to own dogs. The goal this year is to increase the participation of both clubs and individual club members. PAC is happy to accept even small donations (\$5 a month for example). Carl Ashby finished by remarking that if every club member would contribute the amount of his last show/trial entry fee, it would make a very significant difference in what PAC could accomplish.
